Code of Conduct Policy

The following Code of Conduct policy has been developed and adopted by the Muncie Baseball and Softball Association (MBSA) Board of Directors. Its purpose is to insure that ALL players, parents, guests and coaches are given the opportunity to have a positive and enjoyable experience while participating in baseball and softball games with MBSA.

Code of Conduct for Players

- 1) **I will enjoy myself because baseball and softball are games and games are meant to be fun!**
- 2) I will respect my coaches, teammate, other players, MBSA officials, umpires, and all who volunteer their time in helping with my team. I will listen to them and follow their instructions and rules. I will not insult, criticize, taunt or otherwise verbally mistreat them.
- 3) I will never resort to physical threats of actions to resolve a situation. Any occurrence will be immediately directed to an MBSA Board member.
- 4) I will not use disrespectful language or gestures toward any player, coach, MBSA Board member or umpire. If I do, I will be ejected from the game and the game will not continue until I leave the immediate area.
- 5) I will demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times. Win or lose, I will always shake hands with the opposing team and its coaches at the conclusion of the game.
- 6) I will play by the rules set forth by MBSA.
- 7) I will never abuse the equipment or facilities provided by MBSA.
- 8) I will be a contributor to the positive image MBSA portrays. I will always give 100% to my team by doing the best job I can.
